

Parent Permission Form

Congratulations! Your student has indicated a desire to join the Dulaney High School Robotics Club. This club will build a robot as an after school activity and compete at regional competitions. We will also build and compete with VEX robots. Generally the club meets weekly for 1.5 hours on Friday in room 238. The national FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition in Science and Technology) competition has about 1,500 teams competing in 17 regional competitions during the spring 2009 season. This club will require intensive work during the robot build season in January/February of 2010. After robot build we will attend 2 regional competitions that are out of town and will require an overnight stay of 2 nights (3 day competitions). We might also qualify to attend the Championship Event in Atlanta GA in April 2008. During robot build your student will be required to work evenings during the week (Monday – Thursday, 4-7 PM) and Saturdays 10 AM – 5 PM). The club will have to do many mechanical tasks such as cutting and drilling metal, and electrical assembly. A teacher will be with them at all times, but there will generally be no nurse available. There is much to gain by allowing your student to participate, they will learn how to build a robot, raise and manage finances, and compete as a team. There are also many scholarships dedicated to FIRST participants. This is a unique opportunity for your student.
